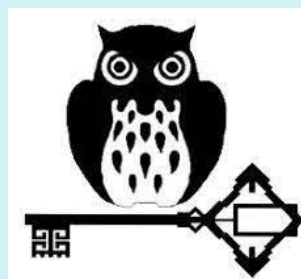

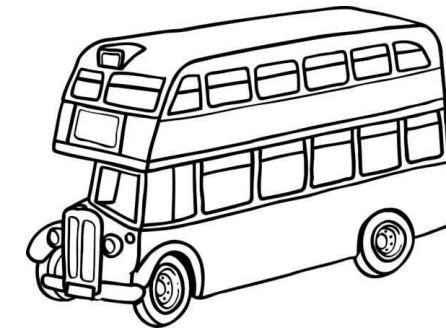

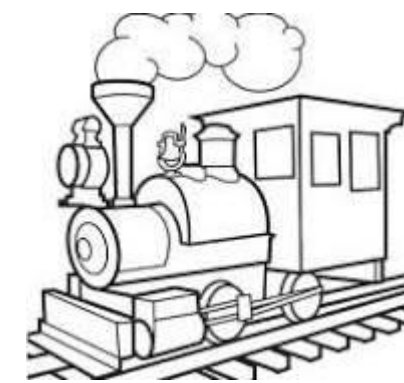

the topic of mobility-summary

The host school will find out some information about the EU policy regarding human rights. The trainers from the leading country will deliver sessions to the students: they will be solving problems, creating ideas for being involved, participating in the activities of simulation. The participants will work in groups (national and international) regarding the topic, debate, deliver public speeches, organize simulations, cases of breaking human rights, applying arts will be creating the message for the EU considering human rights. They will write diaries for the reflection.

The participants will also be exploring cultural places and learning about Romanian lifestyle. The participants are 15-17 years students, 4 from each country, total 24, about 25% from social and low economic backgrounds.

HOW TO GET TO Râmnicu Vâlcea (ROMANIA)

1. [Henri Coanda International Airport \(OTP\) Bucharest](#) is the largest airport in Romania (190km from Râmnicu Vâlcea)

From the airport and from the MARINA TRAVEL-company(for the Turkish team) to the Ramnicu Valcea you may travel with [AmalTour Companies](#).

The transport is done in 3 stages:

1-the Turkish team, on January 14th, at 5:00 a.m., from the bus station-Marina Travel

2-teams from Italy and the Netherlands, on January 14th, at 2:15 p.m., from Otopeni airport

3-the team from Lithuania, on January 15, at 00:30, from Otopeni airport

The Bulgarian team travels by train and arrives in Ramnicu Valcea; from the station to the hotel they will be driven by the hosts from Romania

Students will discover not only how European legislation is adopted, but they will learn to make quick decisions, will be challenged to work in teams, communicate effectively, argue and improve their public speaking skills.</p> <p>How does the Roleplay work?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the players are divided into imaginary political groups and enter the position of MEPs. Through debating topical issues and topics, they learn how European Union legislation is created and how the future of Europe is built. -the role-play reveals the full magnitude of the legislative process, from consultations with stakeholders and interaction with interest groups, to forming political alliances, negotiating with other European institutions and relations with the media. - the participants are constantly informed and guided in the game, they don't need to have knowledge or skills regarding the conduct of the activity. <p>The price includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - accompanying guide in Bucharest; - English speaking guide; - ticket fares ; - sandwich, fruit and water ; - activities highlighted in the tour program;

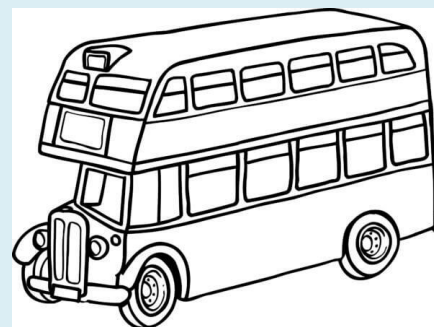
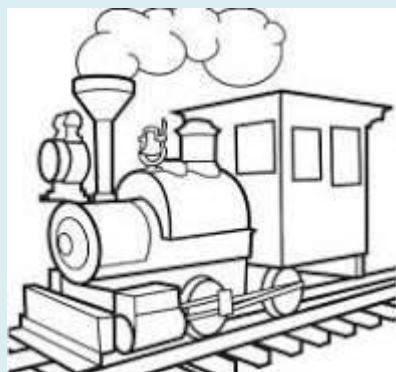
Transport

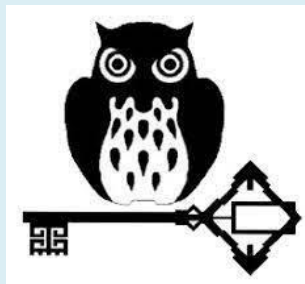
- The Bulgarian team arrives by train in Ramnicu Valcea; the transfer from the station to the hotel will be made by the host team!
