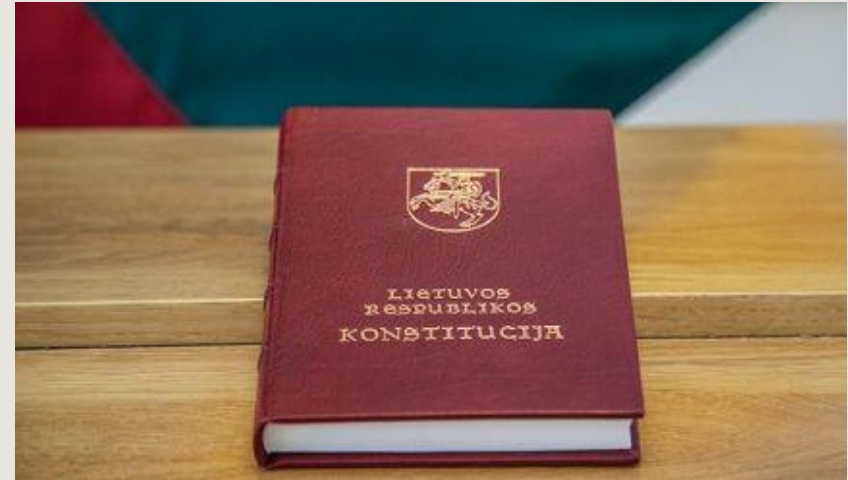
What are human rights?
